

Volunteer Guidelines for serving at Our Redeemer Vacation Bible School

Thank you for volunteering. These guidelines will provide for an inspiring and positive Christian experience for all who attend VBS this year.

Attitude is everything. Being a leader includes leading by word and deed, the example you set and the words you use will have a huge impact. Start preparing now by focusing on Jesus during the good times and the hard times of your daily life. Each leader is expected to adhere to the following principles as a volunteer during Vacation Bible School.

SHOW LOVE AND RESPECT FOR GOD:

1. I will participate in all activities.
2. I will be open, flexible and have a servant's attitude.
3. I will represent God in my words and actions.
4. I will pray daily for self and others.

SHOW LOVE AND RESPECT FOR SELF:

1. I will drink plenty of water, come well rested, and eat regular meals. This will allow me to participate and not be tired.
2. I will present myself accordingly wearing comfortable, modest clothing. Regarding Modesty:
 - Shirts: I will wear a VBS t-shirt (you will receive one at the volunteer meeting) or other shirts without any offensive wording or images.
 - Shorts/Pants: Appropriate shorts or pants. I will avoid extremes: too tight or too short or too baggy.
3. If I must leave my designated area, I will notify the adult leader in charge of my station/crew first.

SHOW LOVE AND RESPECT FOR OTHERS:

1. I will not participate in horseplay or harm others.
2. All of my words and actions will be used to build up others and not tear down, steering clear of any inappropriate language.
3. I will respect the facilities and understand they must remain clean and undamaged.
4. I will not bring anything which will distract me or from being present to others. My cell phone will be on silent/vibrate at the beginning of each day. I can check it when I am away from students, and I will not use apps or games while I am with others.
5. I will report any concerns to the VBS directors.
6. I will not share foods with students. You may be unaware of allergies in your group or in the large group. Our goal is to keep everyone safe.
7. We have a Facebook group that pictures can be posted to. They should not be posted to your personal social media if they have students in them.

BEING PRESENT:

1. I will attend the VBS set up meeting on Sunday, August 1st at 3:30 PM
2. I will make sure I am present and signed in at 8:45 AM each day of VBS.
3. I will stay with my group until all the children have been signed out.
4. I will help my teacher with end of the day cleanup.
