

Summer Camp 2019 Important Information

***Summer Camp Hours:** Summer Camp runs 9:30-2:30 Monday through Thursday for eight weekly sessions beginning June 3rd (closed July 4th). There is no extended care available during summer. Doors will open for drop-off at 9:20am. If your child is not picked up by 2:35pm, this is considered a late pick up. Three late picks will result in your child being withdrawn from Summer Camp, no refunds will be given. Tuition is due Monday of each week that your child attends. We accept check or money order.

***Food and Drinks:** Please bring a packed lunch and water bottle (disposable or refillable) to camp each day, we will be very active throughout the day and we need to keep hydrated! We will provide a snack each day.

***Dress Code:** Play clothes and comfortable shoes (no flip flops) should be worn, we will be outside every day and the children will not be able to play on the equipment/bikes without closed toed shoes. We are here to play and have fun, there is a 100% chance of messy/wet/wild activities ☺☺ An extra set of clothes (including socks & under garments) should be left here at the school. *There will be 4 different "Splash Days" (sprinklers, water table play, spray bottles, etc.) scheduled during camp. If your child attends on a Splash Day: they should come with their swimsuit already on under their play clothes, wearing water shoes (no flip flops!) and bring a bag with dry socks, shoes, undergarments, towel and sunscreen. *Please make sure that your child's name is clearly marked on EVERYTHING that is brought to camp.

***Potty Training and Nap Time:** *Children 3 and under will have a brief rest time after lunch. They should bring a small blanket and/or pillow. *All children who are 3 years old on or before June 3rd must be FULLY POTTY TRAINED (no diapers or pull ups).

***Discipline:** Summer Camp is intended to be a fun and safe environment for all who attend. Discipline issues and problem behavior will not be tolerated. Although we do not anticipate discipline to be a problem, we need you to be aware of St. Gregory's policy regarding the matter. Any child exhibiting behaviors that are harmful to themselves or others will be withdrawn from summer camp and will not be allowed to return. This decision will be at the discretion of the director in consideration of the teacher's input. These behaviors may include, but are not limited to: pushing, hitting, kicking, biting, throwing things, inappropriate talk or language, repeated displays of disrespect for persons or property (after warnings have been given.) If a child continues to exhibit any of these negative behaviors after warnings or redirection have been given, parents will be notified and the child will be sent home. All discipline issues will be handled on a case by case basis.

*If your child is unenrolled from our Summer Camp program for unpaid tuition, disciplinary action, or excessive late pick-ups; there will be no refunds given.
