**JANUARY JOYFUL NOISE:  
HONEYBEES THROUGH HEIFER INTERNATIONAL**

We have collected \$324 toward our \$500 goal for January's Joyful Noise offering. All of the money you donate will be sent to Heifer International to purchase honeybees (\$30 per colony). As our congregation's beekeeper, Ron Small, told us, farmers can create income by selling beeswax, pollen and honey, but the real value of bees is in crop pollination – plants have been shown to produce more fruit and larger fruit when a healthy population of bees is present.
