SUNDAY STAPLE STAMPEDE

Although Lindley Elementary School is not technically our neighbor for the next year or so, the Mission Committee encourages everyone to purchase school supplies for Lindley students who may not be able to afford them.. During the month of August, we will collect school supplies in the little red wheelbarrow in the narthex (or monetary donations in the collection can) to donate to the school. Here are some of the supplies needed: glue sticks, crayons (8 count boxes for kindergarten, 24 count boxes for grades 1-5), dry-erase markers (fine tip and chisel/thick tip), composition notebooks, pink rectangular erasers, folders (plastic/poly with pockets and 2 prong with pockets), scissors, yellow No.2 pencils, colored pencils, highlighters, 3-ring binders (2-inch), loose-leaf notebook paper, multi-colored index cards.
