This year, The OneEvent will be re-imagined as a mission trip, so the format will be very different from the overnight rally that was in Salina. Youth groups will be staying in host churches throughout Omaha and Lincoln, so the youth will interact with other youth groups at their home base churches, in addition to opening and closing worship for everyone. Work groups are arranged by youth group, and you'll be out in the community during the days, with worship and activities at the host church in the evening. There will be small group discussion guides for adult leaders to lead during breaks, and we'll be focusing on Mercy and Justice this year. Individual cost includes lodging; meals for Monday-Wednesday and Thursday breakfast; a t-shirt; a water bottle. All costs are covered by us.
