Message from the Pastor...

September 2023

For the last week, the road I take to get to work has had a sheriff pulled off into a culvert waiting to stop someone for speeding. Right after the sheriff, there is a house that has lots of pumpkins out front. Clearly the occupants of the house are waiting for fall. Waiting. We wait a lot. We wait at a stop light. We wait for the train to cross the track. We wait for our partner to get home from work. We wait on our food to be done. We wait for the coffee to be brewed. And we are waiting for Jesus to return. There is a lot of waiting. What do we do in the liminal space?

We live our lives. We work. We spend time with those we love. We play. We go to church. And hopefully we help our neighbors. Fall is when church ramps up. Summer church is over. All the Sunday school classes start back up. Choir and Bells begin practicing again. Worship committee plans for the fall and the Advent season. Finance starts to create a budget for the next year and a stewardship campaign committee is formed. Nominations Committee starts to look at who can fill different spots on the church's committees. It is a time filled with hope, nervousness and waiting. Finance waits for the different committees to turn in their budgets and then waits for the pledge cards to come in so a budget can be created.
