"Lottie Moon 2025" refers to the annual **Lottie Moon Christmas Offering®** and the associated **Week of Prayer for International Missions**, observed by Southern Baptists from **November 30 to December 7, 2025**. The offering supports the work of the International Mission Board (IMB) missionaries around the world.

About the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering

- **Purpose:** The offering provides 100% of gifts to support IMB missionaries and their ministries in sharing the gospel with unreached people and places.
- **Theme and Goal:** The 2025 offering goal is set at \$210 million to send more missionaries to the field. The 2025 theme is "Together".
- **Week of Prayer:** This is a dedicated time from November 30 to December 7, 2025, for Southern Baptists to pray for missionaries and their global efforts.

Who was Lottie Moon?




Charlotte Digges "Lottie" Moon was a remarkable American Southern Baptist missionary who spent nearly 40 years in China (1873-1912). Her letters home inspired the creation of an annual offering to fund international missions. She selflessly dedicated her life and resources to the Chinese people, eventually starving to death while ensuring those around her had enough food during a famine. The annual offering was officially named in her honor in 1918 to carry on her legacy of sacrificial giving and prayer for the lost.
