FROM THE DESK OF LINDSAY....

One of my favorite passages in the Bible is 1 Corinthians 13: 4-8. I remember being asked to read this passage over and over when Chip and I were doing premarital counseling. The verses are pretty easy to memorize; however, living out the words is a whole different story.

1 Corinthians 13: 4-8 says:

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always preserves. Love never fails.

How would you describe your love for others? Are you a patient soul, or do you drum your fingers and tap your toes while you stew and sigh? Is it hard to make you angry, or does flying off the handle come naturally? Do you keep score with those who have wronged you, ready to dredge up the past to make your point? Do you brag? Do you get green with envy? Ever been rude to someone?

How will we ever learn to love the way 1 Corinthians 13: 4-8 urges us to love? Here is an idea. Write out the words for 1 Corinthians 13:4-8; however, where the word 'love' or 'it' is used, leave a blank. Over the next week or so try to be able to write your name in the blanks when you have a chance to exhibit the quality in real life.

Were you patient at the restaurant when your food took longer than it should to arrive? Write your name
on the " was patient" line. Did you and another family member get into a heated discussion and
you held your tongue instead of bringing up past mistakes? Bravo! Write your name on the " keeps
no record of wrongs" line.

I can promise if you take this challenge, God will give you lots of opportunity to practice the type of love found in



2018 FINANCIAL IMPACT STATEMENT


Dear Church Family,

Thank you!! Because of your faithful giving to our church over the past year, you have helped to meet the needs of our church. The chart below shows we collected 95% of our budget for the General Fund and our expenses have been under control. **However, we can do better.** When our income is less than our budget, that normally means less money is available for Ministries and Programs. That is what happened in 2018. Most of the Ministries did not spend the amount budgeted. So, the fact that we have a Surplus is a little misleading.

In the coming year, we will need to begin repayment of the loan for the improvements you see happening around the church. That loan will be around \$500,000. We would like to see the Ministries have all the money budgeted for them. We also continue to have staffing needs (such as a full time Youth Director, a Technology person, and more). Our church cannot do this without your help and your commitment. Please prayerfully consider how you might help.

The Finance Committee will commit to keeping you more up to date on where we stand during 2019. If you have suggestions, please let me know.

UMW NEWS




