FROM THE DESK OF LINDSAY....

Have you ever heard someone say, "surround yourself with positive people"? It is great to have sunshiny friends in our life. Laughter, smiles, encouragement, and creativity flourish. I mean, who doesn't love a good laugh with your best friend?

There is nothing wrong with having good friends who exude the joy of the Lord. But, I wonder, if we don't make friends with the unpleasant people and personalities among us, what will become of them? I am sure we all feel joy and love when we're with friendly people, but is it the sweet souls or the bitter who need more love? Who is willing to stand next to the Maras?

What, you don't have any "Maras" in your life? You do, they are just the Naomi's who went through bad times and haven't bounced back. Naomi means "pleasant." Mara means "bitter." In Ruth 1:20, Naomi asked all her old friends to stop calling her the name that meant pleasant and to instead call her Mara. In order to see the context of **Ruth 1:20**, lets look at this portion of scripture with the verses before and after it.

"So the two women went on until they came to Bethlehem. When they arrived in Bethlehem, the whole town was stirred because of them, and the women exclaimed, "Can this be Naomi?"

"Don't call me Naomi," she told them. "Call me Mara, because the Almighty has made my life very bitter. I went away full, but the Lord has brought me back empty. Why call me Naomi? The Lord has afflicted me; the Almighty has brought misfortune upon me."

So Naomi returned from Moab accompanied by Ruth – (Ruth 1:19-22)

This was BIG. The entire city of Bethlehem was talking about Naomi coming home! There was cause of celebration, tears of joy, and stories about the "good old days." Bethlehem's sweet sister was back! Except she wasn't pleasant anymore. She was still mourning her devastating loss. She couldn't get out of her sadness even for such an exciting occasion. And Ruth stayed by her side.

Do you know anyone who has experienced a huge loss but hasn't moved on? Perhaps they need a good friend. It takes a lot of energy to be a good friend in someone's life. Those negative, sad, sour, unpleasant people can soak us dry. If we see it that way, it will be that way. But if we see ourselves as ministers of the sweet riches of Christ, then we can invest time and befriend the bitter. Those unpleasant people need the love and friendship of someone who won't walk away.


