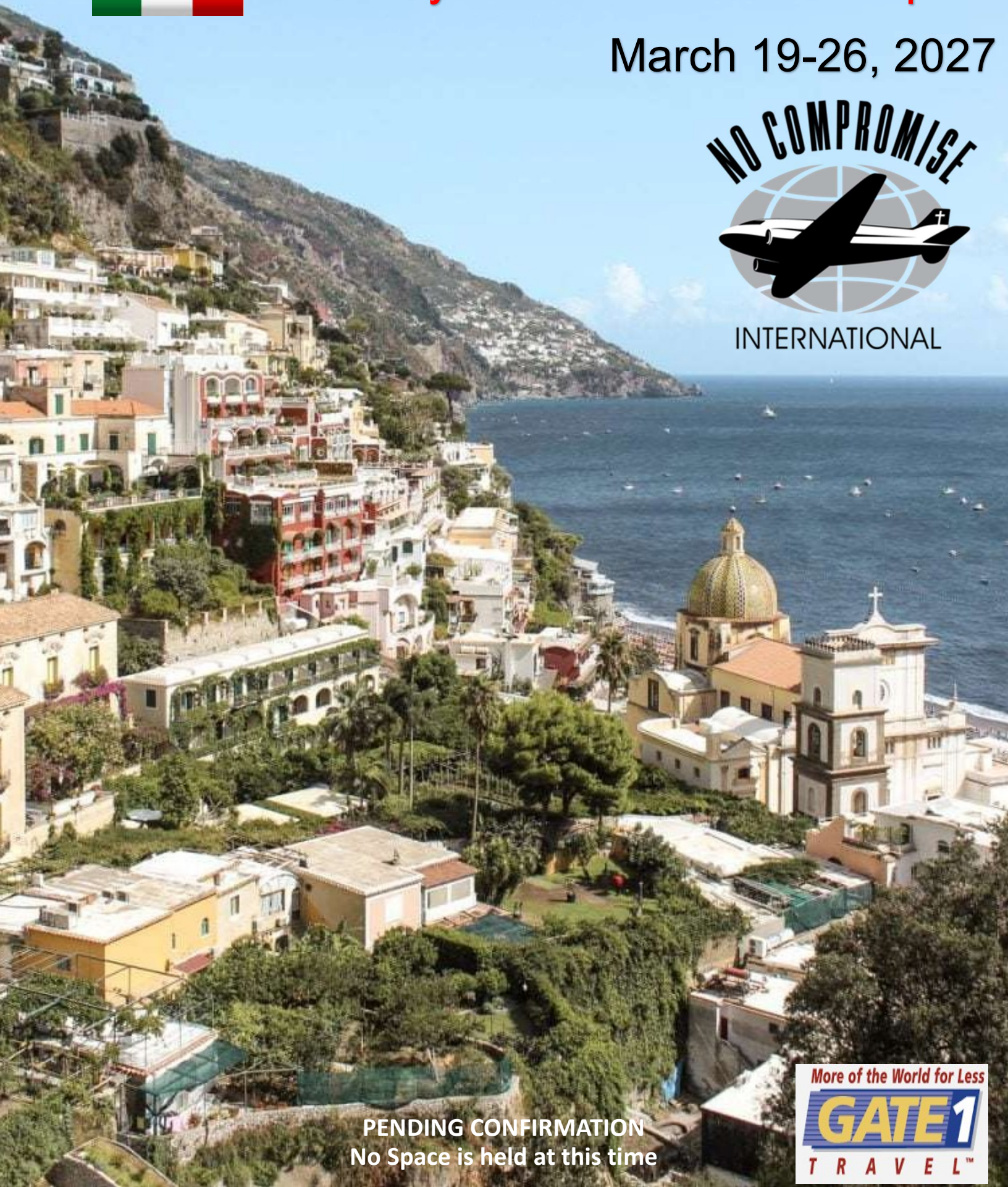

Your Daily Itinerary

DAY 1, Friday, March 19, 2027 - Depart for Italy

DAY 2, Saturday, March 20 - Arrive in Rome
Arrive in Rome and transfer to your hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure in the astonishing city built on seven hills prior to dinner and a well-deserved night of rest.

DAY 3, Sunday, March 21 -

Tour Ancient Rome, Mamertine Prison, Basilica of San Martino ai Monti

The historic tour of ancient Rome begins at the famed Roman Forum, walking through the uneven surfaces of the original central area of the city from which Rome developed. View the triumphal Arch of Constantine, erected by the Roman Senate to commemorate Constantine's tenth year of leadership over the Eternal City. On to view the outside of the mighty Colosseum, the largest amphitheater built in the Roman Empire that seated over 50,000, where gladiatorial contests and public events were attended by the rich, the poor and by the Emperor himself. This afternoon, a visit is planned to the Mamertine Prison, built in the 7th century BC and was situated on the northeastern slope of the Capitoline Hill. The day continues as you travel to Basilica of San Martino ai Monti. Dating back to the 4th century, this church is located near the edge of the Parco del Colle Oppio. Admire the stunning frescoes by artists such as Pietro Testa, Matteo Riccione, and Giannangiolo Canini that adorn the church walls, and see the Chapel of Our Lady of Mt Carmel. Dinner this evening will be on your own.

DAY 4, Monday, March 22 - St. Paul Outside the Wall, St. Sebastian Catacombs, Vatican Museums

Today you will learn and experience the fascinating history of St. Paul on your tour of Rome at the most important sites related to the Apostle Paul. Discover the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls and the Abbey of the Three Fountains. While on tour, your guide will share captivating stories about St. Paul's life and his impact on Christianity. The afternoon brings you to Rome's hidden layers of history beneath its streets and three fascinating archaeological finds. Visit the hallowed St. Sebastian catacombs where, beneath their persecutors' feet, early Christians practiced their forbidden faith. Almost 2,000 years ago, this network of secret tunnels doubled as a place of worship and burial ground. As you explore tombs made of solid rock, you will learn the intriguing history of this sacred spot. The Catacombs tour concludes with a visit the Capuchin Crypt. It was here that Capuchin monks used the bones of their nearly 4,000 brothers to intricately decorate the floor-to-ceiling designs, lending it the macabre nickname of "the Bone Chapel". This afternoon brings you for a visit to the *Vatican Museums and Michelangelo's masterpiece, the Sistine Chapel. Stroll through one of the most important art collections of the world. Admire the Gallery of Tapestries and the Geographical Maps before arriving to the Sistine Chapel, with its great frescoes by Michelangelo. Continue to St. Peter's Square, passing Bernini's famous colonnade to view St. Peter's Basilica, built on the burial site of Saint Peter. Dinner this evening will again be own your own.

DAY 5, Tuesday, March 23 - Naples City Tour

Following breakfast and hotel check out you will depart Rome south for the Amalfi Coast where on route you'll see the magnificent Abbey of Montecassino perched high on the mountaintop in the distance (weather permitting). This was the scene of a huge battle near the end of World War II in which the abbey was completely destroyed but has since been restored.

As you approach the Bay of Naples, you are welcomed by spectacular panoramic views of the sea with Mount Vesuvius towering at a distance.

Upon arrival in Naples, take a walking tour of the city's historic center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stroll through the labyrinth of centuries-old streets lined with grand churches, lively squares, and artisan shops. Tonight, spend the evening at leisure.

DAY 6, Wednesday, March 24 - The Gorgeous Amalfi Drive

Embark on one of the most spectacular drives in the world along the rugged Amalfi Coast, with its dramatic landscapes and amazing panoramas. Nestled into mountains that rise thousands of feet above the sea, you'll see enchanting villages, cliffs terraced with lemon groves, whitewashed villas and sparkling turquoise seas. Drive by Positano and stop in Amalfi, named a UNESCO World Heritage Site, to spend time at leisure in town. Return to your hotel in the late afternoon.

DAY 7, Thursday, March 25 - Pompeii

This morning as you pass the Bay of Naples the majestic Mt. Vesuvius guides your journey toward Pompeii. Visit the city that was frozen in time under a thick carpet of volcanic ash almost 2,000 years ago. Walk through its original streets and view the tragic casts of people attempting to escape alongside their children and dogs, as well as the preserved ruins of the Temples of Apollo and Jupiter, and the Forum. Return to Naples and spend time at leisure before dinner with your Tour Manager
