From your Director of Missions Danny Davis

Happy New Year! Every time the calendar turns to a new year, I am always reminded of this passage Joshua chapter 3, where he and the Israelite people were preparing to cross the Jordan River and enter the long-awaited Promised Land:

² So it was, after three days, that the officers went through the camp; ³ and they commanded the people, saying, "When you see the ark of the covenant of the Lord your God, and the priests, the Levites, bearing it, then you shall set out from your place and go after it. ⁴ Yet there shall be a space between you and it, about two thousand cubits by measure. Do not come near it, that you may know the way by which you must go, for you have not passed this way before."

⁵ And Joshua said to the people, "Sanctify yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." ⁶ Then Joshua spoke to the priests, saying, "Take up the ark of the covenant and cross over before the people."

Three things I would point out about this passage:

"You have not passed this way before" – As we enter into a new year, we are in essence entering into uncharted territory. None of us knows fully what the year 2016 will hold for our individual lives, our families, our churches, or our association. It is a completely new venture, full of unknowns. But the good news is that "the Known" (Christ) far outweighs "the unknowns". We may not fully know what he future holds, but we certainly know Who holds the future. And our future is in Good Hands.

"Sanctify yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." – There are so many great things God wants to do in each of our lives and in each of our churches. But in order for God to work through us, we must "sanctify" ourselves. In other words, we must set ourselves apart unto the Lord so that we are spiritually prepared for the unseen challenges and opportunities that will arise. As we move into 2016, will you commit yourself fresh and anew to the great adventure to which God has called you? Will you dedicate yourself to the spiritual disciplines of prayer and the Word? Will you determine to seek after God and be on mission with Him daily? Start the new year off right by "sanctifying yourselves" unto the Lord.

"Take up the ark of the covenant and cross over before the people." – The ark of the covenant represented the very presence of God among His people. As the priests obediently carried the ark and the people followed, God miraculously provided a way through the Jordan River, which was at flood stage. As we move into this new year, we may come to some "rivers" that appear to be impassible. If we are following the Lord, we don't have to shrink back from the challenge, for God always equips those whom He calls, making a way for us to achieve His purposes. Let's just be certain, whatever we do, that we are always following the Lord and not our own desires.

I believe 2016 is going to be a great year for Tates Creek Baptist Association. I also believe 2016 can be a great year in your own spiritual life. So let's not shrink back from the journey ahead. Rather, like Joshua and the ancient Israelites, let's move out in faithful obedience, fully embracing the untraveled landscape that God has placed before us.
