

Decades ago, as a young boy, I used to lay awake at night in my bed and listen to faraway AM radio stations on my little transistor radio. (NOTE: What I'm talking about here is completely foreign to those of you in your 40s or younger.) Back then, there were just a handful of "Clear Channel" stations sprinkled across the country. You could listen to them from far and wide. One of my favorites nighttime radio stations for Top 40 music was located up in Fort Wayne, Indiana. Its unforgettable call letters were WOWO. A number of you have told me you also have warm memories of listening to "Woe-Woe".

Who would have thought that more than 40 years later, we would hear another strong signal, from the Holy Spirit, backing beckoning us to go to Fort Wayne and to help our brothers and sisters there reach their region with the Gospel? As I write these words, our new partnership with the Northeastern Indiana Baptist Association (NEIBA) is now in full swing. Mission teams from Bethel and Pilot Knob have been earlier this summer. Soon, a team from Gethsemane will be going. And during the week of August 6-13, an association-wide team will be in the area doing construction and leading a Vacation Bible School.

You may ask, why are we going to Indiana? Again, let me remind you. There are 2,400 Southern Baptist churches in Kentucky. But there are only 400 SBC churches in Indiana. The need is great and so is the opportunity. And, in terms of Gospel advancement, there is power in partnership. Please pray for this new endeavor. May it be long and fruitful; above all, bringing glory to God.

By the way, speaking of partnership missions, did you know we had 4 mission teams head to Central Mexico this July? One from Red House, two from First Baptist, and a combined team with members from Berea, Pilot Knob and Mount Tabor. I am so grateful for all of our missionaries!


