From your Director of Missions Danny Davis

At our June Executive Board meeting, we made the decision to have an Association-wide Intercessory Prayer Service on Sunday evening, September 11, 2016, which is the 15th anniversary of the horrific attacks on our nation. We will be praying for revival for God's people and for a spiritual awakening for our nation and our world. Pastor Bill Fort of First Baptist Church has graciously offered to host this unique event. We will be asking all of our TCBA member churches to move their Sunday night service to First Baptist that evening, so that we can all join together and call out to God together. Please mark this special event on your personal and church calendar. The exact time and other details will be forthcoming as plans are made.

Also at the Executive Board meeting, Jeff Prosser, our EKU Campus Missionary, did a great job presenting an overview of the KBC's new Twelve24 initiative. Twelve24 is an effort to reach Kentuckians between the ages of 12 and 24. Shockingly, census and polling data reveals that only 5% of this age group in Kentucky professes an active relationship with Jesus! That means that 95% of Kentucky's middle schoolers, high schools, college students and young adults are not following Jesus. Twelve24 is a means to address this spiritual crisis in our midst. Jeff Prosser is our regional Twelve24 consultant. He has put together a team that will be available to work with churches and help them learn how to better engage this important age group. Training is going to be available to help youth workers and churches develop their own Twelve24 strategies. The first such opportunity is on Saturday, August 13th from 10:00 AM to 12:00 Noon at the Baptist Campus Ministries (BCM) building at EKU. If you would like to attend this training event, please contact Jeff Prosser (jprosser1968@gmail.com or 859-200-0816). In fact, if you have any questions, Jeff would be delighted to meet with you one-on-one. He might even buy you a cup of coffee!

Our first associational mission trip to the Northeastern Indiana Baptist Association (NEIBA) is scheduled for August 6-13, 2016, which is a Saturday to Saturday. This trip will have two components—a construction component and a Vacation Bible School/ Outreach component. If you feel the Lord leading you to be part of this mission, please contact our associational office and secure an application at your earliest convenience. All application forms need to be completed and turned in to us by July 13th. The only monetary cost you will incur on this trip is money for meals on the way up and back, and incidental expenditures you may wish to make. Your transportation, lodging and meals while we are there will all be provided through the generosity of TCBA churches that give to our Mission Fund through the Hamp and Sandra Valentine Offering for Associational Missions.

Our next Bi-Vocational Pastors Gathering is scheduled for Tuesday, July 12th at 6:30 PM. As before, a complimentary meal will be provided. Our guest speaker is Dr. Jerry D. Lowrie, who for 25 years was pastor of Main Street Baptist Church in Williamsburg, Kentucky–my home church and my hometown. Brother Jerry is my "father in the ministry" and has been a key figure in my life. He will have a special word to share with our bi-vocational pastors that night.
