EVENT

East Coast Music Awards (ECMA) April 29 - May 3, 2020 in St John's NL - Awards Show, Showcases and Conference.

OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this RFP is to solicit offers from a technical production company or companies (audio, lighting and A/V) that can provide a complete range of professional services associated with the technical execution of the **2020** East Coast Music Awards and Conference.

Companies may submit proposals for any or all of the venues, as are appropriate. The successful bidder or bidders will be required to work closely with the Technical Director and Event Managers in contributing to the achievement of the objectives of the conference, showcases and awards shows.

COMPANY BACKGROUND INFORMATION

It is the ECMA's mission to foster, develop, promote and celebrate East Coast music and its artists locally, regionally, nationally and internationally.

We strive to succeed in our mission through the execution of our annual event (East Coast Music Awards), educational sessions, trade missions and our International Export Program. We also partner with special industry organizations to offer additional opportunities to our artists.

The East Coast Music Association (ECMA) is a regional collaboration of people in the music industry of Atlantic Canada. We are a registered non-profit association dedicated to the music of Atlantic Canada. Membership is open to all individuals working in any sector of the music industry or those who support the music industry. Membership includes musicians, artists, agents, managers, record companies, studios, media, related corporation and retailers. The ECMA currently has over 1,000 members.

Over the past 32 years, the association has been witness to the successes and struggles of hundreds of East Coast artists. ECMA has been a catalyst, bringing music industry representatives from all over the world here to the East Coast to discover and cultivate one of our greatest exportable resources - our music.  - a) Audio (PA, FOH & Monitors)
 - b) Lighting (Conventional and Intelligent Lighting, Rigging & Trussing)
 - c) Video (Projectors, Screens, LCD/Plasma Monitors, Playback Devices & Cameras)
 - d) Staging (Stages, Room Dress, Barricade, etc.)
 - e) Technicians/Engineers for FOH, Monitors, Stage, Lighting, Rigging & Video
- 2) Please provide profiles and accountabilities of key individuals that will be assigned to this contract, include description of experience with similar projects. Also include a list of any subcontractors that you will be using, including key contacts and personnel that will be assigned to this project. All technicians (FOH, MON, Lighting, Video & Stage) must provide resume and references upon request. ECMA reserves the right to tender each technical position separately.
- 3) East Coast Music Association will provide accommodation where applicable. Please note all technicians are expected to share a room.

- 5) Proposals received after the closing date and time will be disqualified from the competition and will not be reviewed.

- 7) All proposals submitted must identify and comply with the specifications requested unless ECMA specifically requests an equivalent or alternative. Brand names are utilized to designate the type and quality of the product requested. Substitutions offered must be of equal quality and clearly identified and accompanied by information to permit evaluation of the item being offered. Please provide a **complete itemized breakdown** for the cost of your proposal including equipment rental rates, labour, and transportation (trucking, mileage, fuel, tolls, drivers and accommodations) with totals.
- 8) The East Coast Music Association will acknowledge all tenders at the time of receipt and may contact the company for further information to assist in its deliberations.
- 9) All respondents will be informed of the selection decisions should the East Coast Music Association proceed with any one or more of the tenders.
- 10) Proposals will be evaluated not only on the submitted price but also on the quality of goods, delivery, availability of supply, servicing, **added value**, and the capacity of the bidder to meet the requirements in accordance with the criteria stated in the RFP.
- 11) Production companies seeking tender satisfaction should be aware that successful applicant(s) might be awarded singular, various or all components depending upon product specifications and competitive pricing.
- 12) Please note that the successful production supplier must adhere to the production schedule provided. Also, a company representative must be made available for advance consultation.
- 13) Successful supplier must have a minimum Commercial General Liability Insurance of \$5,000,000. Successful bidders will be required to provide a Certificate of Insurance naming ECMA as additional insured. *Please note ECMA does not assume liability for production equipment while in transit.



14) By issuing this tender the East Coast Music Association has made no commitment that it will form a contractual relationship with any of the respondents. The ECMA Board and Staff retain the absolute discretion to use the information submitted to it in any manner it chooses. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the East Coast Music Association will not divulge any proprietary or commercially confidential information contained in the tenders provided that this information has been clearly identified in writing and is not otherwise available in the public domain or has not been provided to ECMA by a third party, without the permission of the owner of the information.
