- No student will be allowed to take any subject course [i.e B.A/B.Sc./B.Com (Hons./Gen.)] if he/she has failed in that **Subject**.
- No one student is allowed to apply if he/she is passed before **2019** and appeared in any final examinations under the University of Calcutta.
