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THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING PROVISIO(S) AS ESTABLISHED BY THE ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT (ZBA)
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CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS:

- Permits, including Zoning Permits **not** involving development, shall expire if the authorized work or Use is not commenced within, or if work is suspended or abandoned for period of, **six (6) months from the date of issuance** with the following exceptions:
 - 30-days or 10-days** for Permits related to Unsafe or Imminently Dangerous properties respectively.
 - 3-years** from issuance or date of decision by ZBA for Zoning Permits involving development.
 - 60-days** for Plumbing, Electrical or Fire Suppression Rough-In Approvals.
 - Any Permit issued for construction or demolition is valid for no more than **five (5) years**.
- All provisions of the Philadelphia Code must be complied with, whether specified herein or not. This permit does NOT constitute approval of any Violation of such Code.
- The issuance of this CO/permit does not affirm that the subject property is federally compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act. Owner remains responsible for ensuring property complies with all local, state and federal requirements.
