



EnduraLED Lamps Limited Warranty

For Professional, Industrial/Commercial Customers and Applications Only

Philips Lighting Company ("Philips") warrants that its EnduraLED Lamps listed below (the "Products") will be free from defects in material and workmanship, and that the lumen maintenance value for the Product shall not fall below 70% of the lumen maintenance value set forth in Philips specifications, subject to the terms and conditions herein.

If a Product fails to conform with this limited warranty for the specified period below, Philips will, at its sole option, replace the Product at no charge or grant purchaser a credit for a future Product purchase. Unit credit is calculated as follows per the warranty period listed in the table below:

(Invoiced Purchase Price (\$) x Unexpired Warranty Period (operating hours)) / Warranty Period (operating hours)

For PAR and R type lamps, the warranty period is based on 1) a typical 8,760 hrs per year operation on a continuous burning cycle of 24 hours per day or 2) 4,380 hrs per year operation on a continuous burning cycle of 12 hours per day. For A-type, MR16 and GU10 lamps, the warranty period is based on 1) 5,110 hrs per year operation on a continuous burning cycle of 14 hours per day or 2) 4,259 hrs per year operation on a continuous burning cycle of approximately 7 hours per day. For candle type lamps, the warranty period is based on 1) 2,920 hrs per year operation on a continuous burning cycle of 8 hours per day or 2) 1,460 hrs per year operation on a continuous burning cycle of approximately 4 hours per day.

For avoidance of doubt, "to replace the Product" does not include any removal or reinstallation costs or expenses, including without limitation labor costs or expenses, shipping costs to return non-conforming Products or any damages that may occur during the return of Product to Philips.

This limited warranty only applies to Products registered with Philips as part of an installation project within thirty (30) days from date of installation. This limited warranty is subject to the following additional conditions:

2. The Products have not been subject to accident, neglect, abuse, misuse or acts of God.
3. Adequate records of operating history are kept and available for inspection by Philips.
4. A Philips representative will have access to the failed Products and the fixtures used to operate them. If the fixture or other parts become suspect, the representative shall have the right to invite other manufacturers' representatives to evaluate the lighting system components.
5. The Product has been purchased directly from an authorized Philips distributor/dealer.
6. This warranty is limited to lamps purchased for use in regions that are within the jurisdiction of the United States and Canada.
7. Purchase receipt for the Product is available for inspection by Philips.

The warranty and remedy set forth herein do not apply to Products, parts, advice, assistance or service which Philips furnishes to purchaser as a business courtesy. The warranty is not applicable to any Product which is used in violation of any applicable standard, code or instructions for use, including those contained in the Standards for Safety of Underwriters Laboratory, Inc. (UL), Standards for the American Standards Institute (ANSI), in Canada, the Canadian Standards Association (CSA).

THE FOREGOING WARRANTY IS EXCLUSIVE, AND THE SOLE REMEDY FOR ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, IN CONTRACT, IN TORT OR OTHERWISE ARISING FROM THE FAILURE OF PRODUCT AND IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING ALL WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE WHICH WARRANTIES ARE HEREBY DISCLAIMED.
