

Race is a social construct

Races are real only in a social context & are constructed abstractions of identity that some of the majority of a given population recognizes as real

Locally specific (indigenous, nonindigenous)

Class-based assumptions

Inclusive group think extrapolated from groups to individual

Borrows biological race assumptions

Local & personal experience extrapolated to other

When class membership is unequally distributed race & class become confounded

Dominant culture against subordinate culture

Hair, skin color, physical features, morphology
