TASTING NOTES

This luxurious Cabernet Sauvignon radiates depth and elegance from the very first sip. Its deep violet-crimson color hints at the richness within, while aromas of blackberry, dark cherry, and plum mingle with violet, warm spice, and a touch of tobacco. On the palate, layers of dark and red fruits unfold seamlessly over silky, rounded tannins, creating a wine that is both powerful and refined. The finish is long and lingering, leaving a lasting impression of opulence.

BACKGROUND

Alta Nova is sourced from one of Napa Valley's most revered high elevation areas. The mature vines of Cabernet Sauvignon produce grapes that lend extraordinary structure to a wine driven by finesse. The iron rich soils and Western facing slopes offer a depth of complexity which is difficult to achieve from the valley floor and certainly set this wine apart.

Winemaker Britt Nichols is one of the best kept secrets in Napa, crafting wines under the Nichols label from top vineyards in the Valley. Britt's stints at wineries such as Chappellet, Jordan, and Peter Michael have allowed her to learn at some of the best addresses in California, as has working with super-star winemaker Philippe Melka.
