



### 2023 Estate Vineyard Pinot Noir

“Coming from the vineyards above Bressay, the ruby-hued 2023 Pinot Noir DuMOL Estate Vineyard is based on a blend of Calera and Swan clones. It reveals aromas of ripe red cherries, cinnamon, raspberries, orange peel, and wildflowers. The palate has tremendous tension and more wound-up nervous energy, with fantastic linear drive. It’s a spectacular wine that will only improve with another several years in bottle. Drink 2027-2050.” - Audrey Frick

### 2023 Ryan Pinot Noir

“Coming from all Goldridge soils, the 2023 Pinot Noir *Ryan* is from Martini and Calera selections and incorporates 20% whole clusters. Its herbaceous character leans toward a slightly more rustic edge, the nose opening to notes of ripe cherries, mossy earth, and crushed flowers. Medium to full-bodied, the palate takes on more concentration and has a lovely richness, ripe tannins, and classic Russian River character with a hint of warmth. Drink 2026-2040.”

### 2023 MacIntyre Estate Vineyard Pinot Noir

“Bright ruby in color, the 2023 Pinot Noir Macintyre Estate Vineyard is from 8-year-old vines, mostly small-berried Calera clone vines, and was fully destemmed. It’s forward and exuberant in the glass, with hints of blue fruit, fresh violets, pine needles, and dewy earth. Medium to full-bodied, it has a cooling, minty lift throughout, elegant length, and a youthful, energetic structure. Drink 2025-2040.” - Audrey Frick

### 2023 Chloe Chardonnay

“The 2023 Chardonnay *Chloe* is from the Flora Marie Vineyard on Eastside Road, on volcanic red clay, gravelly soils on a plateau bench, and the rest is from behind the vineyard house on clay and sand. One of the richer wines in the range, it’s ripe but also savory on the nose, with golden peach, toasted incense, hints of toasted spice, and savory underpinnings. The palate is full and has some added depth of structure, with elegant length. Drink 2025-2035.”

### 2023 Estate Vineyard Chardonnay

“The higher elevation cousin to the Bressay, the 2023 Chardonnay DuMOL Estate comes from a two-acre section of the vineyard planted to the Mt. Eden clone of Chardonnay. From this protected, tree-shaded site with high-density spacing (which ripens about a week later), the wine displays a bright yellow color and offers a wonderful, focused drive on the nose, with notes of fresh ginger, fresh apples, lime, and saline. It has a compact core with good density, although it ultimately showcases its more cool-vintage character with its vibrant energy and persistent length. Drink 2025-2037.” - Audrey Frick

### 2023 Charles Heintz Vineyard Isobel Chardonnay

“A medium yellow hue, the 2023 Chardonnay Charles Heintz Vineyard *Isobel* offers the ripeness and decadence this site captures, though in this vintage, it leans more toward the mineral side, with white peach, salted pineapple, white flowers, and lemon peel citrus. The palate has medium to full-bodied richness, though it has a very elegant feel, with a lovely, savory texture and a long finish. It was aged in cigar-shaped barrels. Drink 2025-2037.”

### 2023 Eddie's Patch Syrah

“A youthful magenta/purple-toned color, the 2023 Syrah *Eddie's Patch* is named for a vineyard they’ve had since 2000 on Limerick Hill overlooking Fitch Mountain, planted in 1996. With 85% of the fruit coming from this vineyard and the rest from a section planted in 2000 near the vineyard house, the wine opens with a lovely perfume of graham cracker spice, olives, fresh plum, and violets. Full-bodied, the palate has excellent structure, plush tannins, and a long finish. Drink over the next 12-15 years.” - Audrey Frick
