The Motley / Rose of Pinot Noir / 2021

THE WINE: The curious characters in Erin's home county influence the philosophy behind The Motley, a spirited blend of Pinot Noir. In one small spot on the map, a variety of personalities combined with differing ideas, dreams and experiences helping define a unique place.

WINEMAKING: Picked to preserve the natural acidity, the juice was fermented in neutral barrels and stainless steel tanks, using ambient yeast.

TASTING NOTES: Pale pink wine with subtle combination of citrus, Honeycrisp apple, and light hints of fresh herbs and wild raspberries on the nose. The cool, maritime freshness on the palate focuses on coastal minerality and pretty, bright fruits wrapped with delightfully low alcohol and vibrant acidity.
