THE VINEYARD: In the sub-appellation of San Lucas, located 12 miles south of King City, lies San Lucas Vineyard. The climate is similar to the Rhône region of France. Blustery afternoon winds, known as the mistral in France, are ever-present in the Salinas Valley and San Lucas has similar degree days to the Rhône region.

LABEL STORY: Erin's maternal grandmother, Eugenia, would serve cowboys an early campfire breakfast and transition to church tea in the afternoon. Her remarkable contributions to family and community inspire The Country Wife, a wine both humble and sophisticated.

TASTING NOTES: The aromas are fresh and clean with hints of blood orange and tangerine plus an underlying minerality typical of the rosés from Provence. The acidity is persistent and a beautiful compliment to an array of foods; but being wonderfully low in alcohol, it is delicious on its own.
