TASTING NOTES

Exceptionally aromatic, the 2023 *Solari* opens with layers of dark spice, cedar, and violets, followed by an abundance of deep blue fruit, cassis, and graphite. As the wine unfolds in the glass, subtle savory notes emerge beneath the fruit, adding complexity and dimension to an already captivating nose.

The palate is remarkable in both breadth and weight, carried by a brooding core of dark fruit counterbalanced by fresh acidity that gives lift and energy to the wine. Ultra-fine and luxurious tannins provide the textural framework, building a compelling interplay between power and elegance with each sip. With time in the glass, it continues to reveal layer upon layer of dark fruit, violet florals, baking spices, and a mesmerizing mix of savory bay laurel, cassis, and vineyard-driven minerality.
