

2007 KNIGHTS VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON



TTrue to the vineyard, this wine is made with 100% estate Cabernet Sauvignon. It is a robust wine that showcases the balance of power and elegance. A first glance at the deep, dark ruby color fringed with mahogany suggests a wine of great character and complexity. The nose is redolent of intense, concentrated red and black fruit with hints of chocolate and tobacco, finely-framed by delicate oak. Each sip reveals a new flavor dimension; black currant, blueberry, dark Bing cherry and plum mingle with tobacco, leather, cocoa, black pepper, and allspice. Supple tannins dance around balanced acidity to give a silken finish that goes on and on. While this wine is drinking beautifully now, it will gracefully age 15-20 years past the vintage date.
