

DEAD HORSE Cabernet Sauvignon | Red Mountain | 2013



Winemaking Notes

Washington's finest Cabernet Sauvignon sites provided fruit for the 2013 Dead Horse. More mature sites like Ciel du Cheval and Red Willow provide texture, nuance and character; and younger sites like our custom plantings on Quintessence and Force Majeure have added purity, vitality and structure to our flagship program. The warm 2013 Vintage allowed us to harvest all our Cabernet and Merlot in the month of September, between the 7th and 26th. As in years past, every lot was fermented in 1.5 and 2 ton open-top fermenters for 9 to 12 days. Every efforts is made to treat the wine as gently as possible; the product in never put through pumps and punching down the must caps gently twice per day. Fermentation rounds are performed twice daily, as to monitor fermentation and track when the wines are ready to be lightly pressed into barrel. The wine was aged in 72% new French oak for 21 months, and bottled on July 9th, 2015.

Tasting Notes

The 2013 Dead Horse is deep, brooding dark-red from the center to just inside the edge of the glass. With the first swirl, the wine offers pure, densely-packed aromas of crushed violets with fresh plums and blueberry. After opening, the wine delivers more concentrated tones of blueberry compote mingling with vanilla. The palate is dense, yet, refined with supple texture with a finish that adds weight and complexity with outstanding length.
