Winemaking Notes

The 2016 Long Haul is composed primarily of Merlot from Yakima Valley's Red Willow Vineyard. With an average vine age of 25 years, and planted on ancient soils that were above the Missoula floods, Red Willow Merlot offers a savory aromatic profile and a complex depth and intensity on the palate. The warm 2016 vintage allowed us to harvest all of our Merlot in the month of September. The wine was fermented in a combination of 1.5, 2 and 5 ton open top fermenters for 7-10 days. Every effort is made to treat the wine as gently as possible. The must is never put through pumps and gentle punch downs occur twice per day. The wine is lightly pressed to barrel, where it finishes primary and malolactic fermentation and is aged for 21 months in 64% new French oak. The wine was racked twice prior to being bottled on June 22nd, 2018.

Tasting Notes

Our 2016 Long Haul offers plum, cassis, and savory aromatic profiles on the nose that morphs into a lush entrance of black fruit, caramel, tea, and earth. Silky, velvety tannins combine with mid-palate structure and acidity that leads into a lengthy finish.
