Vintage:

The 2021 Napa Valley vintage smooth and uneventful, which was a real joy for us after a difficult fire season in 2020. During the harvest, we saw low yields across the board, with intensely flavored, small berries. An early bloom and set, gave way to a dry growing season, with cool nights, sunny days and no major heat spikes. This resulted in grapes with concentrated flavors, fine grained tannins, and a powerful vibrancy. The resulting wines sit on a smooth frame and are expected to age well for many years to come.

Tasting Notes:

The 2021 Spring Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon showcases pure fruit characters of dark plum, black cherry, anise and lavender. The wine is rich and silky, with freshness and firmness of tannins that coat the palate. It intrigues with its deep frame of chocolate covered cherries that come along with flavors of cassis, black forest fruits, black olive, and exotic spices. Its broad structure, chalky tannins, and acidity lends itself to a bright, generous, and lingering finish.
