Paul Doyle:

As a prosecutor, I would interview the complainants. I would interview the parents of the child. I would look for ulterior motives for a child to make something like this up and vet what I was told. I learned through that process that there's information that I can obtain from the defense lawyer that could be helpful in successfully prosecuting the case or making a decision to get rid of the case. That has allowed me to provide the type of information for those accused in situations like this to a prosecutor in hopes that the case may potentially go away.
