WHAT IS ADVENT?

Advent begins four Sundays before Christmas. It is a period of worshipful waiting in which many Christians make themselves ready for the birth of the Lord, Jesus Christ. Celebrating Advent typically involves prayer, and realignment with the will and word of God.

The circular evergreen wreath on the table, is a symbol of eternity and unending love. The five candles represent **HOPE**, **PEACE**, **JOY**, **LOVE** and **CHRIST**. One candle is lit each Sunday as a part of the Advent celebration. This is week four, today we will light the candle representing LOVE.
