- Appointed Subject Matter Expert (SME) to establish proper data structures across hospital system. Upon hire. was appointed by SIS work with Hospital executives to accomplish proper data structures and update policy & procedures, as well as assist them in making properly informed decisions for implementation of their product. Was hired to take the lead on other projects as needed to insure client executives were comfortable with decisions. This had not been done before nor has SIS done this with any other employee since.

Defined gaps and created best practice workflow that led to software merge/implementation. Delivered SIS system that improved the efficacy of adjacent systems such as inventory and billing.
