RACE REVIEWS

OTB – EASTER EGG SCRAMBLE – APRIL 14, 2018

112 motorcycles and quads, and 22 UTVs. Two medical transports, 1 life flight, all minor injuries.

It was stated that all team riders have to finish at least one lap in order to receive race points. Each team should pay attention to who they are racing and report if not racing at least one lap each.

D38 GRAND PRIX – MAY 12, 2018

131 motorcycles and quads. 1 serious injury.

Price was raised \$5 this year and will be the same next year (2019).

D38 table skirt was updated with money from the Grand Prix.

Sponsors donated stuff to be given to new members for signing up with D38.

Thank you Henry Daly for scouting new territory at GP!

It was suggested that the Open and Vet class races start farther apart so people can race both.

More help is needed for GP.

ROADRUNNER – RATTLE SNAKE CHASE – SEPTEMBER 29, 2018

137 motorcycles and quads. Two injuries before race, not race related.

It was reported that near Wheeler Road was not marked very well, and there was a UTV parked on the course. First lap there was a person there directing racers, second lap there wasn't. It was suggested that there should be a person there for entire race.

I8 – MONSTER MASH – OCTOBER 13, 2018

83 motorcycles and quads, and 21 UTVs. No injuries during race. 1 volunteer had minor injury.

A group of racers missed turn and check 2.

It was stated that there isn't a whole lot that can be done when markers are knocked down during bike race, for the UTVs. Ben will have sweepers pick-up downed markers at next race.

Wrong way and Danger signs are hard to see, very small and white. Ben will look into making larger.

It was suggested that GPS for race be given to UTV racers at riders meeting.

LESAR

Only 8 volunteers and they are getting burnt out. The last couple of years lost 4 EMTs.

Asking for volunteers from Clubs, if you have excess volunteers, let LESAR know. Volunteer does not have to be an EMT, you have to be trained in basic first aid and CPR. You have to pay for basic training. If you volunteer, LESAR reimburses for mileage to get to and from race. 1 person needed to drive UTV.

There has to be 1 EMT and jaws of life for every 25 miles, 2 stay at the LESAR trailer.

It was suggested that some of the D38 Officials be trained in basic first aid and CPR. It is a 4 hour training that usually costs about \$25.
