RACE REVIEWS

FULL THROTTLE – PLASTER CITY DASH - NOVEMBER 11, 2017

76 motorcycles and quads, 19 UTVs. 2 minor injuries which were checked and released.

BLM was checking for fire permits.

Had to move some of the course due to lots of traffic from lanterns.

BLM – PITS AT DIP

BLM said not allowed to pit at the Dip anymore due to lots of traffic crossing over onto military land. Maybe move to other side of mud hills.

DISTRICT 38 SPONSORSHIP

Three businesses are bidding for sponsorship. Sponsorship covers insurance for UTVs. Rob is speaking to Club Presidents regarding sponsorships.

NEW RULES

1. UTV has to be full body with radiator in stock location. Vote: Yes 4, No 8. **NO PASS**
2. Change UTV volunteer points to make driver work a UTV race in order to get volunteer points. Vote: Yes 1, No 12. **NO PASS**
3. UTV Stock class – Has to have full body. Vote: Yes 7, No 6. **PASS**

OPEN

1. George Ryan stated that there is \$50 million in funds for grants. Very difficult to get. It is \$50,000 to get an area surveyed. EreK Kudla, AMA rep., says that the AMA can help us fill out the forms.
2. GP lost money this year. Less racers and D38 gives trophies and finisher pins. Had to pay track for extra workers. It was suggested to raise entry fee by \$5 for 2018.
3. Survey balance \$42,214
4. D38 balance \$4,283

5. AMA Congress Delegates: Rob Niemela, Steve Fenton, Dave Kendrick and Kirk Hester

Erek Kudla representative from the AMA was at the meeting.

1. AMA rule change- Riders must have goggles on at start of race.
2. AMA Congress is changing. 1 member from each RDO grandfathered in for two years.
3. AMA Congress is going to breakup into divisions: Motocross, off-road, track, etc. We will have our own section for off-road now.
4. Risk Management is to be done every year. Referee training is online. AMA is working towards minimum amount of time trained.
5. Heather Wilson is new Recreational Manager.
6. There are only twelve people in Off-Road Division of AMA.
7. Sanctions went from 536 to 580.
8. D38 is doing a great job getting race results to AMA.
9. If you have a protest for a race, the forms are in the back of the AMA rulebook.
10. Let AMA know of any events so that they can put in magazine.
