EMPIRE 8 ANNOUNCES MEN'S BASKETBALL ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

Ray Bryant of Utica Named Player of the Year

ROCHESTER, NY – Senior forward Ray Bryant of Utica College was named Empire 8 Men's Basketball Player of the Year. Corey McAdam of Nazareth College was the unanimous selection as Rookie of the Year. Rob Kornaker, who led St. John Fisher to a 20-5 regular season record and the top seed in the Empire 8 tournament, was recognized as Coach of the Year.

Bryant, the only repeat first-team all conference selection, enters the conference tournament averaging 16.3 points and 9.5 rebounds per game. He is shooting 48.4 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from three-point range, and 72.0 percent from the free throw line. A two-time Player of the Week, Bryant led the Pioneers to an 18-6 regular season mark and the second seed in the Empire 8 tournament.

Senior Dan McSweeney of St. John Fisher was the only other senior named to the first team all-conference squad. He averaged 12.6 points and 7.4 rebounds per game in the regular season, shooting 59.8 percent from the free throw line.

Sophomore teammates Jeff Bostic and Sean Burton of Ithaca each received first-team all-conference recognition. Bostic, a forward, enters the Empire 8 tournament averaging 15.3 points and 6.9 rebounds per game, shooting 55.2 percent from the field. Burton, a guard, is averaging 15.1 points and 4.9 assists per game, shooting 91.0 percent from the free throw line and hitting 62 three-pointers.

Sophomore guard Doug Herring of Utica garnered first-team honors, averaging 15.8 points, 5.1 assists, and 4.3 rebounds per game. Herring leads the Pioneers in field goals made, free throws made, assists, and steals, while ranking second in 3-pointers.

McAdam, who also earned second-team all-conference accolades, was named Rookie of the Year after averaging 14.6 points, 7.4 assists, 5.5 rebounds, and 3.2 steals per game. He was named Empire 8 Rookie of the week five times.

Kornaker, who has guided St. John Fisher to four consecutive league titles, garnered Coach of the Year honors for the fifth consecutive time.
