Emporis, the global building database, is out with a new list that ranks the world's ten largest shopping malls by gross leaseable area. The biggies, it turns out, are almost all in Asia. The Mall of America doesn't even make the list. The only North American mega-mall, according to Emporis, is the West Edmonton Mall in Canada.
