Follow I-95 S to exit 19.

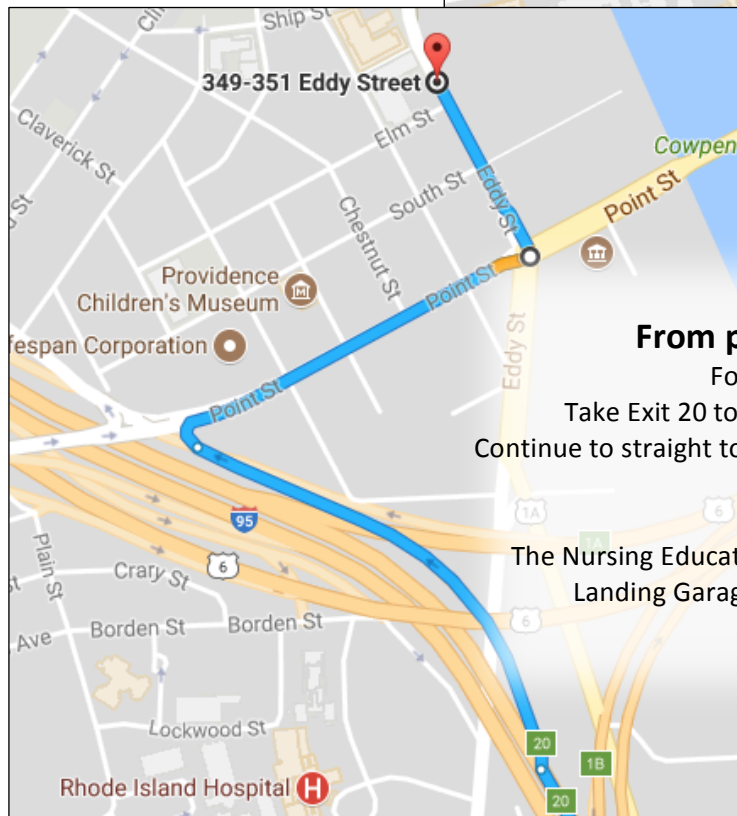
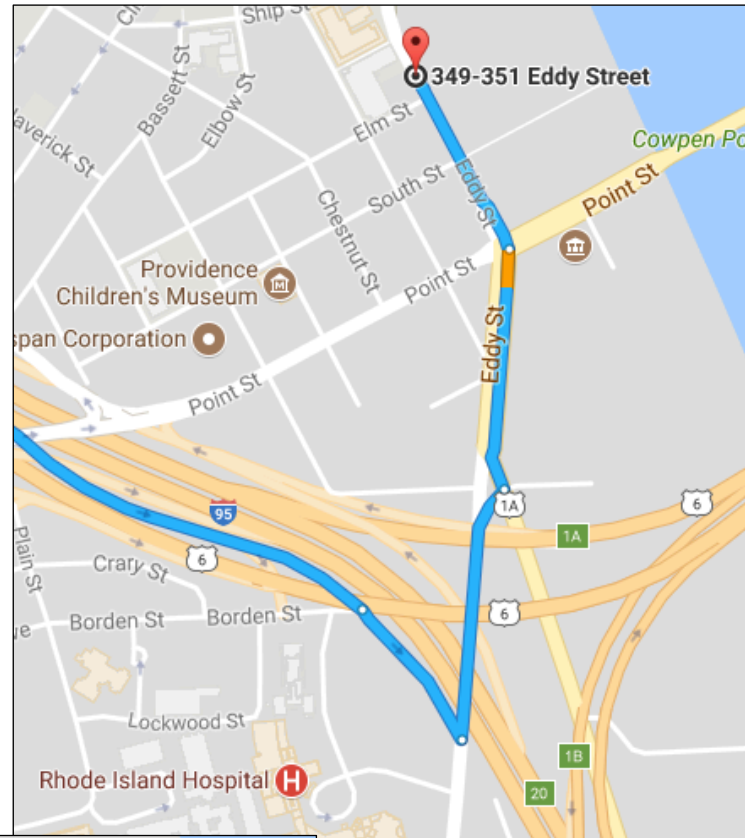
Continue on Borden Street to intersection of Borden and Eddy Street.
