**Hotel Accommodations**

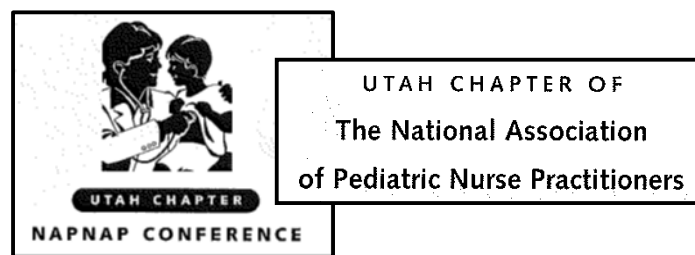
There are several hotels available in Salt Lake City. We do not have any affiliations with any local hotels.
