C. Student Membership shall be open to any registered nurse currently enrolled in a program for nurse practitioners, nurse midwives, or certified nurse specialist. Students shall pay dues and may serve on committees, but may not vote nor hold office.		
D. Honorary Members shall be open to persons who have made outstanding contributions towards the mission and visions of LANP and are		

approved by the Board of Directors. Honorary members may serve on committees, but shall not pay dues, may not vote or hold office E. Retired Members shall be open to nurse practitioners, nurse midwives, and certified nurse specialists who have reached retirement age and have retired from active practice. Retired members shall pay dues and may vote, hold elected or appointed office and serve on committees.
