GET TO KNOW THE SPEAKERS

Stacia Hays, DNP, ARNP – Dr. Hays is a board certified Pediatric Nurse Practitioner and the track coordinator for the Pediatric Primary Care Program at the University of Florida. Her research and scholarship interests include nursing advocacy and health policy, and improving the resiliency of at-risk children. Dr. Hays has presented on the topic of Human Trafficking to a variety of national healthcare specialty organizations.

Gary White, MPH – Mr. White is the Associate Director of the Hillsborough County Anti Drug Alliance (HCADA), a non-profit, community-based organization working to end substance abuse and addiction through education, collaboration, and advocacy. Mr. White completed 21 years as a military healthcare nurse before becoming certified in Public Health, a Certified Worksite Wellness Program Manager, and a Tobacco Treatment Specialist with HCADA.
