

VOTERS GUIDE

Over the past few weeks the ANPA PAC has been surveying candidates to discover their positions on Nurse Practitioner issues. Here are the results of their responses divided by ANPA Districts.

The questions that were asked.

- Do you believe Nurse Practitioners should have Full Practice Authority? (referred to as "FPA" in chart)
- Would you be willing to sponsor a Full Practice Authority bill? (referred to as "FPA" sponsor in chart)
- Would you be willing to sponsor a bill that expands medication prescribing for Nurse Practitioners? (referred to as "Rx Expand" in chart)
- Would you be willing to sponsor a bill that allows Nurse Practitioners to be Primary care providers? (referred to as "PCP" in Chart)
- If you are elected, can we connect you with a nurse practitioner to help you review upcoming healthcare bills and answer any questions you may have? (not on chart all respondents answered yes)

- Is there a bill or legislation that you are considering running that would affect nurse practitioners or their patients? (referred to as "Bill" in chart)
- Have you ever worked in the healthcare field? (referred to as "Worked in Health" in chart)
- Do you plan on becoming a member of the health policy Committee? (referred to as "Committee" in chart)
- Have you voted against Nurse Practitioner bills in the past?
 (referred to as "Hx Against" in chart)

Answers were given in yes or no format; if there was no answer the chart will remain blank. If the legislator has questions and has not fully answered there will be a question mark. Only legislators who responded are featured in this guide.
