To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a registered POPS member for at least 1 year prior to the annual meeting. This includes being current on annual dues.
2. Member has not received a POPS scholarship in the past 5 years.
3. Member is not a current member of POPS Executive Board.
4. Complete an application form for the POPS at IPOS Continuing Education Scholarship.
5. Fulfill the requirements of being an active committee member outlined as follows: attendance at monthly phone conference meetings, delegation of tasks pertaining to program planning, presenting podium lecture(s), and attendance at the 2019 IPOS program.

Interested applicants should complete the attached application by going to the link listed on the announcement for the scholarship awards on the website. Deadline for receipt of applications is midnight on May 2. Recipients will be notified by email by May 10. Both scholarship recipients will be awarded free Nurse/Allied Health/PA registration for the 2019 IPOS meeting (estimated value \$899).

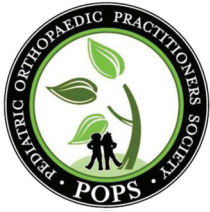
