What does GetWaiveredTX offer?

- Free buprenorphine waiver training across Texas
- Technical assistance throughout the 4-step waiver process:
Register, Attend, Complete, Enroll (RACE).
- Organizations interested in hosting a waiver training;
We will come to you at no cost
- Available for physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, students, residents, and advanced practice registered nurses
- Free continuing medical education credits

What does TxMOUD offer?

- Funding for office-based treatment (OBT) and medications for opioid use disorder (MOUD) through the execution of contracts with MOUD providers
- Training and technical assistance
- Connection to a network of MOUD providers
- Online educational materials, tools and resources

What will OBT Contractors receive from TxMOUD?

- Funding for OBT and MOUD (including buprenorphine & naltrexone)
- Free provider & patient access to wraparound services, including:
(1) contingency management through the WEconnect recovery support app
(2) cognitive behavioral therapy through the online CBT4CBT program
- Training opportunities and online resources to assist with treating OUD

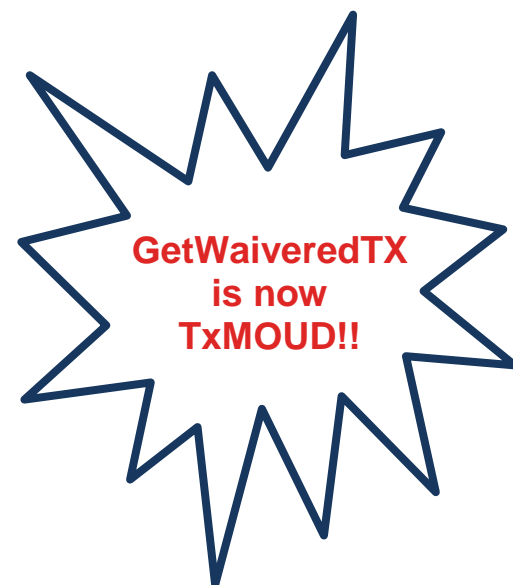
