Ask if symptom onset

was sudden²

- ☐ HEADACHE
- NAUSEA/VOMITING
- SEIZURE
- SYNCOPE (FAINTING)

POSTERIOR STROKES can be more **DIFFICULT TO IDENTIFY**⁴

Common symptoms include:

- DIZZINESS
- ☐ DIPLOPIA (DOUBLE VISION)
- ☐ DYSARTHRIA (DIFFICULTY SPEAKING)
- ☐ DYSPHAGIA (DIFFICULTY SWALLOWING)
- DYSTAXIA (LACK OF COORDINATION)
