Legislation-Katie	APN joint agreement in NJ still in place. Now in lobbying phase. Now more momentum as pandemic proved APNs practice safely with increased "buy in" by politicians and other leaders. Legislation in NJ considering including home palliative care within programs to meet PC needs. State medicaid in other states have included home palliative care within programs with noted benefits. PCHETA- in legislation for about 15 years. absorbed into Build back better program. Hackensack Meridian seeking money from PCHETA for PRESS (palliative care research education supportive services stewardship) program will have money for PC research. Katie working on this.	May pass soon?? Katie recommends communicating to political leaders but will share her ideas with board members prior to public suggestions. Legislation has not been formally drafted as yet. Would include high risk patients, may be designed as a bundle, different reimbursement programs in states. Budget mostly going toward education provided through organizations. Seeking institutions to provide money for educational programs.
