How a bill becomes a law: The bill is read on the chamber floor to the House and the Senate and assigned to a committee. The legislators on that committee will be the ones voting for or against passing the bills on for a vote in the general assembly. Bills affecting Nurse Practitioner scope of practice are assigned to the Public Health, Welfare, and Labor Committee. Once it is passed by the House committee, it is then sent to the Senate committee for debate. It will be debated on the chamber floor and must have majority vote of 51 in the house and 18 in the senate. Once it is passed in both chambers with any amendments, it is taken to the governor to be signed.
