He earned a BS in Mathematical Economics from Wake Forest University and a JD and PhD in law and economics from Vanderbilt University. Prior to his fellowship, he served as a law clerk to Judge Carolyn Dineen King on the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit. Benjamin's research focuses primarily on the law and economics of healthcare. He has published extensively on the scope of practice laws governing nurse practitioners and physician assistants. He has also published papers focused on medical malpractice, organ transplantation, and cannabis access laws.
