

Policy Pearls by Katie Wahler, ARNP, FNP-C, CRC

Washington Legislative Session Update from AUWS Legislative Committee:

This is the second year of the biennium session, so is only 60 days (compared to 105 days in the first year) – lots of work to be done!

Bills AUWS is watching/supporting/opposing:

SB 5373/HB 1495 - Requiring equal reimbursement for advanced registered nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and physicians. As of I.II.24- there is no update on the payment parity bill - both are retaining status from 2023 session and remains in the Senate Ways & Means Committee. In addition to AUWS support, WSNA is supporting, as well.

SB 5960/HB 2II5 - allows for NPI on abortion prescriptions instead of provider name (our Lobbyist Devon Connor-Green will listen to testimony and we will wait on that to take a stance).

HB 1954 - protecting providers who get disciplined in other states for gender-affirming care, especially important when they have compact license - AUWS is in support.

HB 2066 - Addressing affordability through health care provider contracting. Would require insurance carriers to contract with all hospitals in a system, among other things. Devyn will listen in on this bill before a decision on stance from AUWS.

Policy Pearls by Katie Wahler, ARNP, FNP-C, CRC

SB 6144 - Establishing a prescribing psychologist certification in Washington state.

This is a 26 page bill that outlines stringent requirements (requires them to get a master's degree in addition to the PsyD, plus 500 hours supervised training, plus no less than supervised 100 individual patients), but there is opposition from WSMA/psychiatrists, even some psychologists. Intent is to increase persons to prescribe- and is an interesting comparison to the ND bill requesting prescribing for controlled meds. This also wouldn't allow opioids except for OUD. A few other states do have this. WA Psych NP assoc is neutral with concerns but they have collaborated with group interested in this bill. AUWS will remain neutral at this time.

SB 5184 - The hearing happened I/I2/24, including testimony from CRNA group. It is likely to move on out of committee. AUWS is in opposition of this bill- which establishes new licensure of anesthesiologist assistants.

HB 204I - authorization of collaborating practice between PAs and physicians instead of a delegating practice. AUWS supports.

ARNP title change bill (no bill number yet- this bill will change title from ARNP to APRN to align nationally) - still waiting on getting a sponsor. More info to come.
