No individual may serve more than 6 consecutive years on the Board

Candidates will submit CV/resume and describe pertinent experience and interest in role

\*Exceptions may be considered by the Board; interested candidates are encouraged to apply for nomination regardless of membership term

# Open Positions

### Student Representative

- Term: April 2024-April 2025
- Advocate for CNS student members, special projects as needed

#### **President-Elect**

- Term: April 2024-April 2025; then President April 2025-April 2027
- President-elect term orients to role and function of President
- President serves as Chief Executive Officer of Affiliate, presides over Board meetings, and ensures rules a properly enforced in all deliberations; serves as Affiliate representative to NACNS

### Secretary-Elect

- Term: April 2024-April 2025; then Secretary April 2025-April 2027
- Secretary-elect term orients to role and function of Secretary
- Secretary keeps true record of meeting proceedings; convenes bylaw review committee

#### Treasurer

- Term: April 2024-April 2026
- Maintains financial records of the Affiliate; submits financial reports; receives payments to and makes disbursements from Affiliate accounts as directed by the Board

### **Board Members at Large**

- Term: April 2024-April 2026
- Participate in work and decision-making of the organization; responsibilities may include membership coordinator, legislative liaison, or academic liaison
