Submitted abstracts will be reviewed and notification of acceptance will be provided by August 21, 2026.

Submission Instructions

Single-spaced, one-inch margins, Times New Roman, font size 12. Word limit is 500 words
APA 7th Edition Guidelines

Each podium presentation will be 60 minutes in length

- **Name, email, home address, credentials**
- **Describe your qualifications and background and experience**
- **Attach your resume**

Title:

Learning Objectives:

- What are the expected changes in knowledge, skills or attitudes.
- Recommended 3 objectives.

Pharmacology Content:

- Pharmacokinetics and clinical application of drugs
- What percentage of presentation does pharmacology content represent.

Presentation Description:

- Should include an introduction with background information and an overview of topics to be discussed
- Significance of the topic in terms of incidence and prevalence and rationale for the topic's importance.
- Key points to be covered in the presentation in a logical order

References: All references should be within the last 5 years.

Abstracts for research, quality improvement projects, evidence-based projects or practice innovations should have the following structure:

Title: Clear and concise title which reflects the presentation content

Background: Provide context for the project or research, highlighting the problem or issue being addressed and its significance.

Learning Objectives: three suggested

Methods/Approach: Briefly describe the methods used to gather data, conduct research, or implement the project.

Results: Summarize the key findings or outcomes of the project

Conclusions: Discuss the implication of the findings and how they contribute to the field of advanced practice nursing
