Independent Study: Inserting LARC Immediately After Childbirth

The 2013 CDC *U.S. Selected Practice Recommendations for Contraceptive Use* recommends long acting reversible contraception (LARC) to patients immediately after childbirth as part of a full range of contraceptive options. This course addresses the indications for insertion of LARC immediately following childbirth. Participants will view a video demonstration showcasing correct postpartum IUD (PPIUD) insertion technique.
