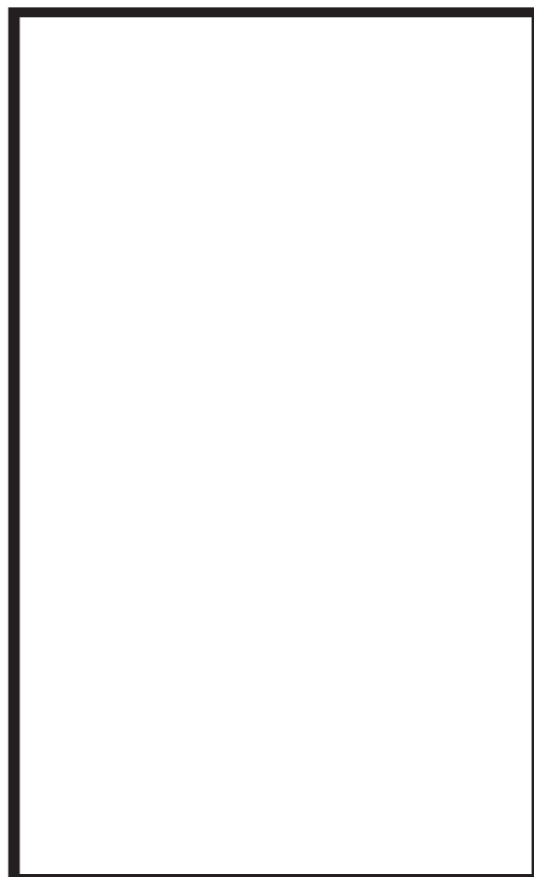

At the end of the ramp, turn right (West) onto Old Madison Pike. Go about .5 mi and turn right onto Voyager Way. Turn left onto Explorer Blvd. and go about .3 mi. Turn right onto Discovery Dr. Take the 1st left onto Moquin Dr. Turn right onto Hudson Dr. and take a left into the Jackson Center parking lot.

From Madison/Decatur via I 565: Take I 565 towards Huntsville. Take Exit 14 towards AL-255 N/Research Blvd. Merge onto AL-255/Research Blvd. north. Take the Madison Pike Ramp. At the end of the ramp, turn right (West) onto Old Madison Pike. Go about .5 mi and turn right onto Voyager Way. Turn left onto Explorer Blvd. and go about .3 mi. Turn right onto Discovery Dr. Take the 1st left onto Moquin Dr. Turn right onto Hudson Dr. and take a left into the Jackson Center parking lot.
